

Which Methodology is Best Suited for Your Organization?

Triniti supports both Agile and Waterfall methodologies. While neither is perfect, it is important to understand that PMBOK (Project Management Body of Knowledge) clearly identifies the central role of Project Management as managing the equilibrium of cost, quality and schedule. Agile methodologies focus on incremental realization of business requirements, so organizations that focus more on data and less on documentation can leverage these benefits. In addition, data capture of project activity in a structured database is mandatory - not in Excel, Word or PowerPoint. If your organization wants to avoid these commitments, then Waterfall is right for you. In either case, the project must be tracked in MS Project or a similar tool, not in Excel or Powerpoint. Triniti has templates for both methodologies. Our only requirement is that whichever methodology you pick, you will have to plan and execute using the same methodology. You cannot plan Waterfall and execute Agile as many organizations unknowingly do.
